

### Huckins Tri-Ath-Loon

n June 1, 2014, we hosted our first women'sonly sprint triathlon, "the Huckins Tri-Ath-Loon". Approximately 50 athletes competed as individuals or on relay teams in this USA Triathlon (USAT) sanctioned event.

The sprint triathlon was a ½ mile swim, a 10 mile bike ride and 3.1 mile run and the course was located in and around Camp Huckins. This event generated over \$28,000 in scholarship funds. The funds raised will provide 19 girls with a two-week Huckins summer camp experience.

Taking top honors on the day was U.S. Triathlon team member Meghan Skidmore, 30, who resides in Intervale. Skidmore, also competed at the World Triathlon Championship in London last fall, set the official course record in a time of 1 hour, one minute, 59 seconds. Lee Winer, 31, of Maynard, MA, was second and Deirdre Gaudreau Wadsworth, 31, of

Portland, ME rounded out the top three. Both Winer and Wadsworth were campers and counselors at Camp.


