Favorite Things

“Jody, what was your favorite part of the Camp’s 90th season?” “Rekindled Friendships!!!” From our opening 90th Reunion Weekend in June, to our closing Women’s Weekend in October, I witnessed so many Huckins alumni reconnecting with friends — it was truly heartwarming. The “Huckins Spirit” continues to connect us all. The entire summer was an amazing tribute to the Huckins family who through their generous gift in honor of “their beloved Nellie” created a summer camp for children.



Camp continues to give our campers (this past summer 1,397 girls) that much needed respite from the busy “real world” and finds them enjoying swimming, shooting an arrow at archery, late night star gazing, flying in a sailboat across the lake, or making a clipboard at the craft shop. This year, the generosity of our donors has allowed us to make many improvements and upgrades. We added two new sunfish, more paddle boards, and a new jet ski (as a rescue boat) to our small crafts area. Our kitchen replaced two old grills for a brand new state of the art “Vulcan Industrial Range” that can grill over one hundred pancakes at the same time. The roof of our dining hall was enhanced by adding 142 photovoltaic solar panels that will collect electricity all year round — another way we are keeping Camp as green as possible. Our Senior Division bath house had a well-deserved upgrade with a new cement coating added to the shower walls and a new floor throughout. Most importantly, all of the toilets were replaced with new water-saving toilets saving three gallons of water per flush (x16 toilets x 100 campers per session) This equals over 600,000 gallons of water saved each week.

Last spring our Health Center received a face lift. We refurbished our dispensary area, improving the flow of campers in and out of the Health Center. This spring the staffing area, where our nurses reside during the summer, will be renovated to provide more housing for our nurses and their families. Work continues on the Camp Director’s home, and John and I look forward to moving into the newly renovated “Palace” by March.

Our facilities continue to be a priority and this past fall we hosted a Charrette (a master facilities planning process) with our staff, board members and alumni. We continue to upgrade and refurbish camp to keep it well maintained. All of these upgrades, additions and improvements would not be possible without your support.

Huckins continues to be blessed with many donors supporting our Camp Scholarship Fund and our Scholarship Endowment Fund. In 2017, 196 campers received scholarship support. Making camp available to all, regardless of one’s ability to pay, continues to be a priority for our Board and Leadership.

Thank you to all of our volunteers, staff, families, friends and donors for helping us keep Camp Huckins “constant and true” for 90 years. We look forward to the next ten years as we prepare for Camp’s 100th!

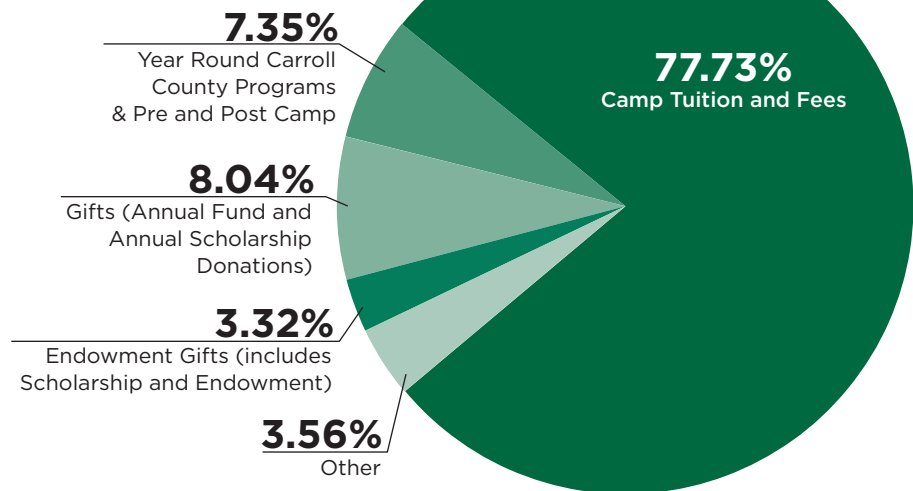

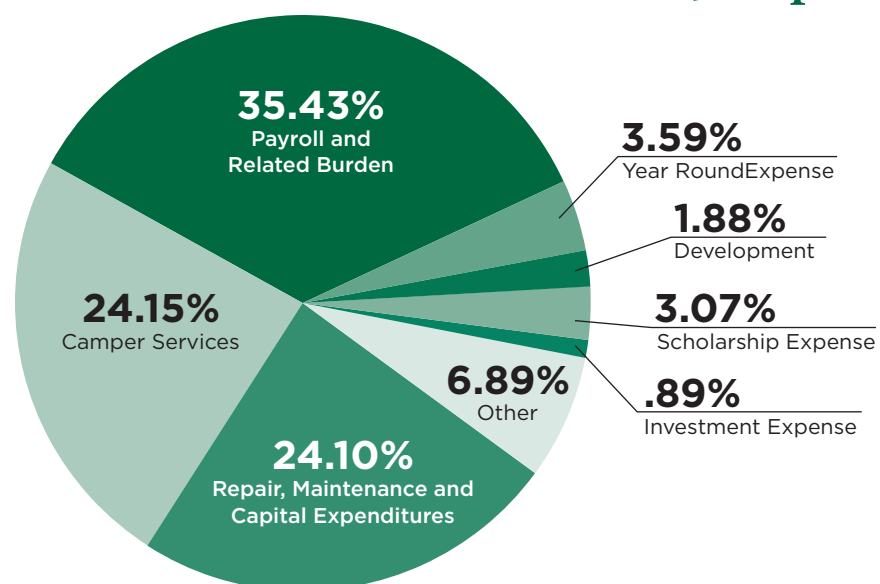

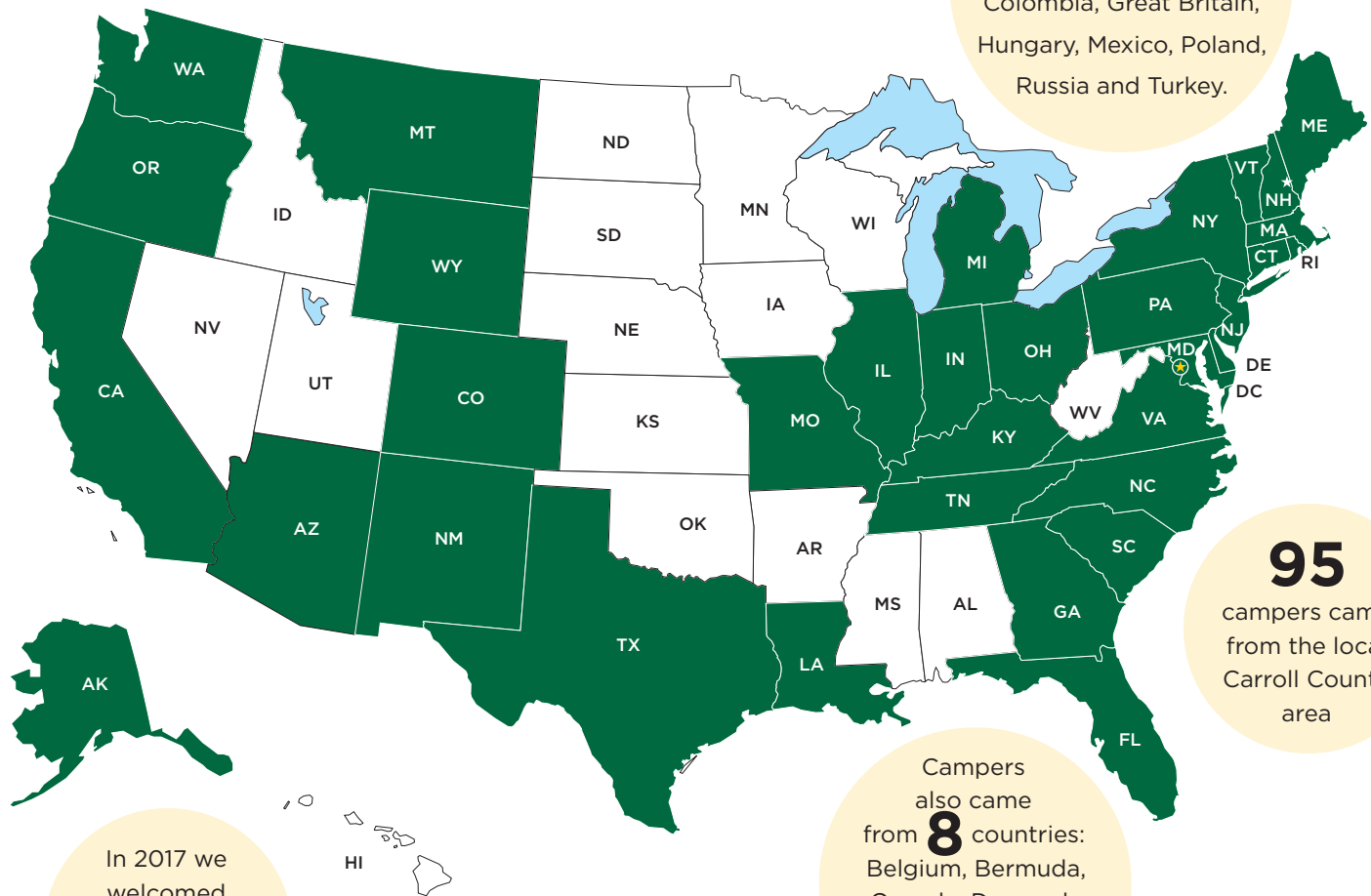

2017 Giving Tuesday

#GivingTuesday was established in 2012 by the 92nd Street Y in NYC as a day to encourage giving back during the busy holiday shopping season. The day has become an international movement and continues to grow in popularity and impact.



Camp Huckins has participated in #GivingTuesday for the past four years. This past year, we teamed up with Camp Belknap to create a “friendly” Young Donor Giving Challenge. We asked families who had “feet in both camps” to participate in a matching challenge. Each family donated \$250 to create a match in an effort to encourage donors to give. The camp with the most donors received well-earned bragging rights. Additionally, and perhaps the more-coveted prize, is that the losing camp director (or in this case, directors), spend a day next summer wearing the other camp’s gear with many promised

photo ops! Although we encouraged all to give, the match was in place for donors who had attended camp in the 2000s. The challenge was promoted through email and social media and caused quite a buzz. In the final tally, both camps surpassed our previous #GivingTuesday fundraising totals, with Huckins raising over \$24K on November 28th, and cleanly defeating its dear brother camp 163 to 27. The blankets, made entirely by "blanketeers," are sent to children who are displaced, have been diagnosed with serious illness, or have experienced another traumatic event.

In the true Nellie spirit, campers of all ages (Girls, Mother/Son, Mother/Daughter, Family and Women Wellness Campers) donated their free time and creativity to craft

dozens upon dozens of fleece blankets. Through the generosity of families, alumnae, and local companies such as Ragged Mountain Equipment, Camp

Huckins Charrette

The term “Charrette” (little cart) first appeared in the late 1800’s when architecture students at the Ecole Des Beaux-Arts in Paris who needed to rush designs to their instructors, placed their drawings on a cart called a charrette. Today the word is often used to describe intense, interactive brainstorming sessions held early in the design stage of a project and involving key stakeholders.

In 2007 the design firm OCBA led Camp Huckins in a design charrette and from that first brainstorming weekend together, a campus master plan grew that laid the foundation for a major fundraising effort for Camp. Now, ten years later and after the completion of a successful first-ever Capital Campaign, Huckins can point to a number of important



upgrades to our facilities. Thanks to the generous support of so many loyal Huckins alumni and friends, we now enjoy a stunning lakefront Chapel, renovated tennis courts, a new craft shop deck, and an impressive Leadership Division. A new maintenance building helps to better support our vast camp infrastructure, and the new Director’s home (now nearing completion) will be a centerpiece at Camp for years to come.

Building on the success of this first experience and after the completion of a wonderful 90th celebration at Camp this summer, an engaged group of Huckins board members and other key stakeholders returned to camp in early November for a second charrette experience. We spent the weekend dreaming and imagining further improvements to the place we all love so much. Join us now in our countdown to Huckins at 100, and stayed tuned for updates on our most recent charrette experience.
