Celebrations!

We began the Camp season celebrating the retirement of the amazing Howard Trask. Huckins staff, friends and family came together to honor Howard's 32 summers as our Maintenance Director. We thank Howard for all of his time, hard work and dedication to Camp Huckins. We were so blessed this summer to have so many returning counselors and Program Staff who were so committed to making camp the best it can be for our campers.

On May 22, 2018 the Board of Directors celebrated the opening of our new year-round camp director's home by having the first official Board meeting in the "Palace" basement. Living in the new "Palace" is a dream come true and it was a joy to share with our campers and families on change days. Our family loves living and entertaining in the sunny, open concept living space with a view that never gets old! The downstairs meeting /community space with bunk beds was constantly used by staff who chose to stay in camp for their days-off. The porch, overlooking the lake, is the perfect spot for most meetings and John and I enjoy eating our meals outdoors during the off season. I loved giving private tours at night to many of our Senior cabins.

We had many Camp improvements in 2018 thanks to the generosity of our donors. Our new "Lollipop Loop" designed exclusively for mountain bikes was one of the additions to the Sports Field this summer. This mile-long mountain bike trail winds through the woods near the Horse Barn. Our campers loved riding bikes on the new bike trail with its tricky switch backs. Another sports-oriented addition, thanks to the generous grant from The Robert and Dorthy Goldberg Foundation, was the new elements on our Ropes Course — the tire swing, the spider web, the multi-vine traverse, and a new cargo net. The campers enjoyed the many challenges it provides and many of our local school groups enjoy a day on the Ropes Course throughout the fall and then again in the spring. On the other side of camp, the newly renovated and enlarged Health Center provided much needed family housing for our Nurses.

We continue to upgrade our facilities and the maintenance staff built and replaced new cabin screens for all of our Senior Division cabins and upgraded the cabin fire escapes. This project will continue this spring when we do the Middler Division cabins. New "Gaga Ball" pits in the Junior and Middler division quickly became hot spots and many campers enjoyed this dodge ball type game. The final project of the year was a new piece of playground equipment for the Junior and Middler Division. Our "Lunar Blast"



was installed in late October and it is quietly waiting for the campers of 2019 to climb to the top. All of these upgrades, additions and improvements would not be possible without your support.

Camp Huckins is a unique place that has celebrations each and every day. In the Dining Hall and at Flag we celebrate camper accomplishments by giving our camp Al-A-men cheer. Small celebrations and encouragement are part of our everyday life as campers challenge themselves by making new friends, learning to do new activities, and just navigating camp alongside their cabin mates. We are so fortunate with your support of our Camp Scholarship fund and our Scholarship Endowment fund. These funds allow us to make camp available to all, regardless of one's ability to pay. In 2018, 198 campers received scholarship support. This is truly something to celebrate!

Our Huckster and Candlelight ceremonies are always a very special celebration time for our campers and staff. Our Hucksters have the opportunity to share what is important to them and Candlelight is the perfect time for reflection, singing and saying goodbye. This summer we celebrated 185 campers becoming Hucksters, and 19 of our staff received special recognitions. Our Family Camp Week had an amazing Huckster ceremony where we had a 5-year family, a 10-year family, a 15-year family, a 20-year family, a 25-year family and a 30-year family.

Most importantly, I would like to celebrate you, our friends, families, alumni, donors and volunteers. Thank you for your continued support and for helping us make each camper feel celebrated.

While I haven't had the pleasure of meeting Nellie Harmon Huckins' granddaughter personally, alumna Kristen (Parthe) Brown took her family — a group that consists of three generations of alumnae — to visit her in Florida during February vacation. I can't wait to learn more about her granddaughter and the family who gave us the gift of Huckins.

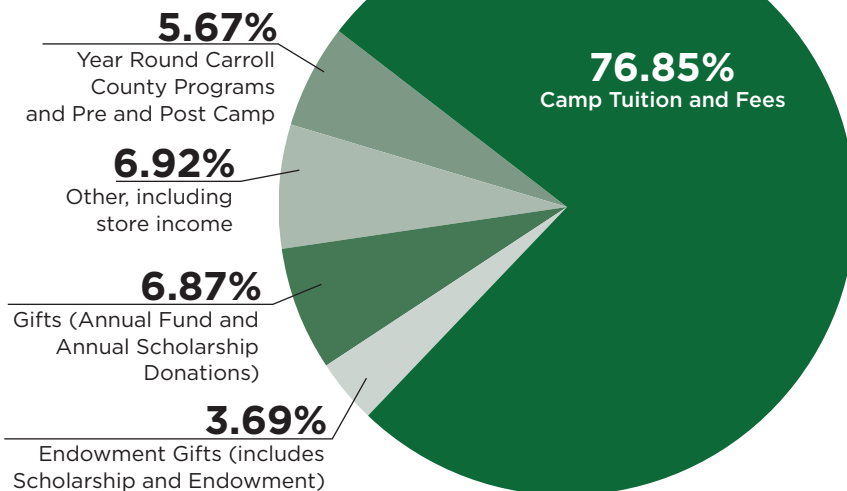

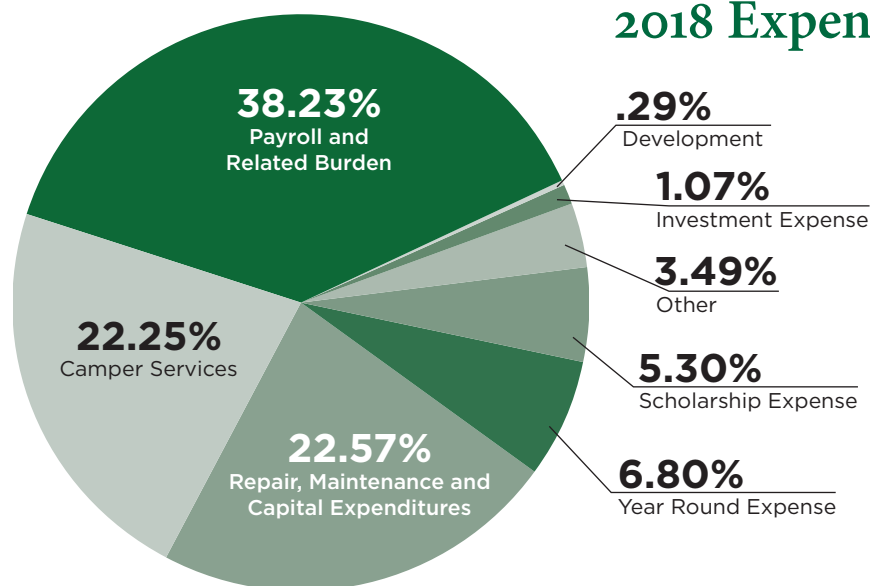

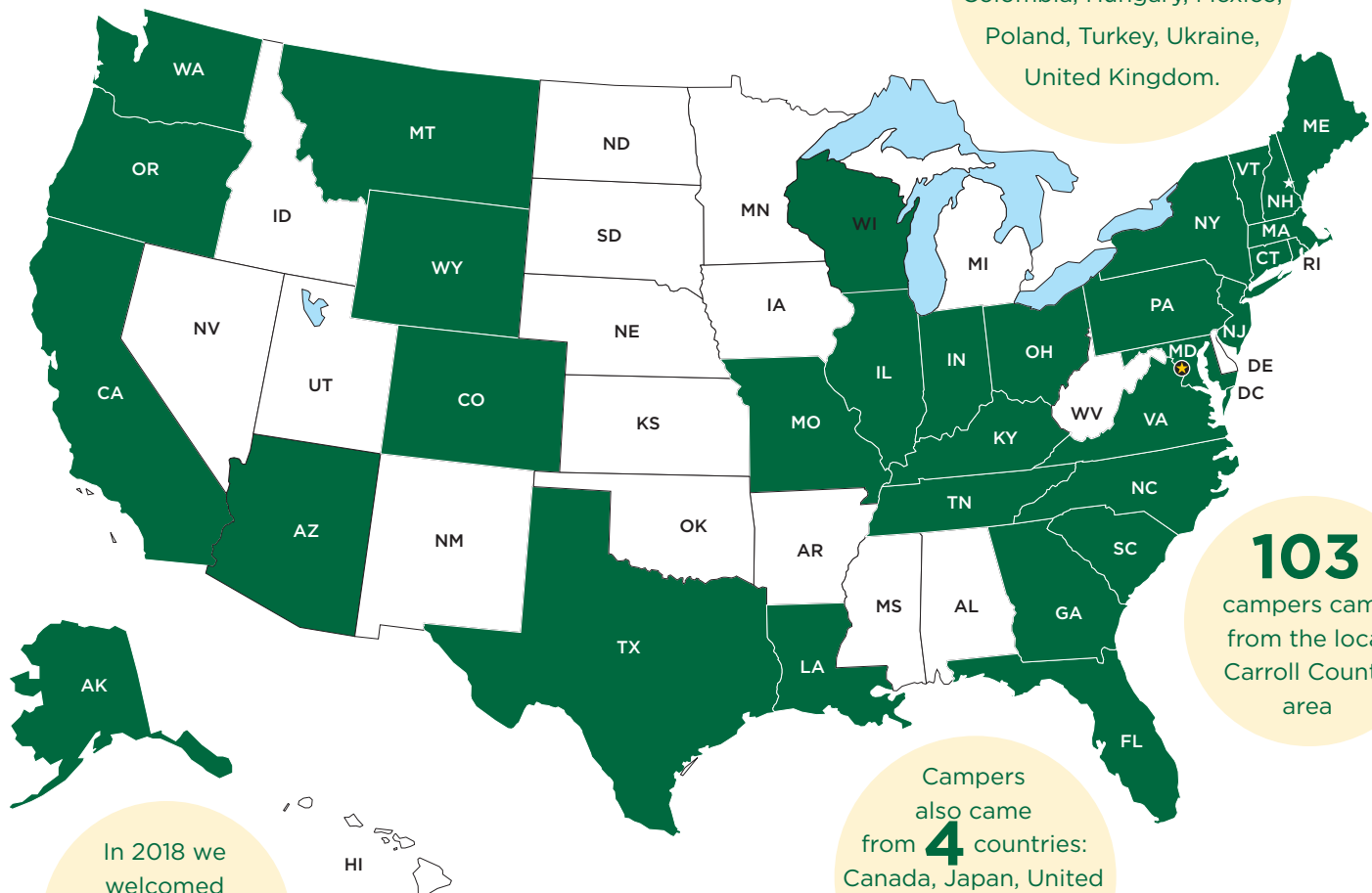

In 2018 Camp made the decision to stop using paper or plastic cups during our All-Camp cookouts at the Waterfront and Sports Field.

In 2017, we used more than 14,000 plastic cups and spent \$857 and in 2018, we used less than 1,000 cups and spent only \$60. Campers and students during our pre-post season programs were encouraged to bring their own refillable water bottles with them to camp. Huckins water bottles were available for purchase in the camp store. Campers filled and refilled their bottles in the sinks at the Dining Hall and bath houses.

In 2019, thanks to the generous support of the Robert and Dorothy Goldberg Charitable Foundation and a former Board member and staff grandparent, there will be two Elkay Outdoor Bottle Filling Stations at camp.

Giving Tuesday

For the fifth year, Camp Huckins participated in #GivingTuesday. As in 2017, Camp Huckins and Camp Belknap partnered to create a Young Donor Giving Challenge to encourage donors (anyone who attended camp from 2000 to the present) to make a donation.

Our goal for the day was a combined 150 donors. What was at stake? The camp with the most donors for the day would receive bragging rights and free “executive level” community service. The event was promoted through emails and on social media. During #GivingTuesday, Huckins Social Media featured wonderful videos from campers, staff and alumni sharing why they give and encouraging others to give. There was an amazing response by our



campers, staff and alumni. At the end of the day of November 27th, Belknap and Huckins were excited to report that our goal of 150 donors had been reached. Alamen to Huckins who had cleanly beat the brothers of Belknap 110-40! As promised, in 2019 Steph and Seth Kassels, Co-Directors of Camp Belknap will be invited to Camp to help with

HIVE Project

The CCYMCA/Camp Huckins has been selected to participate in the Center for New Hampshire Nonprofits' year-long pilot project to increase volunteer engagement.

The HIVE (High Impact Volunteer Engagement) project is a cohort-based program that helps organizations increase their volunteer capacity through a strategic pilot project. During the 12-month period a group of two of our volunteers — Board member Kathleen Mulkern and alumna Molly (Mullins) Greenwood — and two of our staff members — Kara (Smith) Couture and Stephanie Paine — will develop and implement a new volunteer-driven effort for early elementary students, with the help of a coach and Beth Steinhorn, President of VQ Volunteer Strategies.

The goal of our pilot project is to increase the reach of the Carroll County YMCA/Camp Huckins in the local community through a school-based YMCA youth empowerment program, the Super Hero Training Program. The Super Hero Training Program will provide an opportunity for students K-2 to learn, model and demonstrate confidence, caring, honesty, respect and responsibility through a 10-week interactive and empowering experience led initially by Kara Couture and two community volunteers. After successful completion of the pilot, it is our hope that the Superhero Training Program will be extended into other elementary schools in our area and run by community volunteers with oversight by Kara.
