

Tips for the 2025 Application Process

All Families

- Be sure your browser is up to date. We suggest Google Chrome or Firefox. Safari sometimes has issues with our application software.
- Be sure you check the step-by-step instructions to know what information you will need to apply.
- Your application time will be the time the application is submitted not started so be sure to have all information ready including two emergency contacts.
- If you are applying for multiple siblings, it is fine for one parent to apply for all children. All siblings will be given the application submitted time of the first application. Please note siblings in the same grade will **NOT** be placed in the same cabin.
- Historically the first and fourth session are a little easier to get into. The more flexible you are with session choices the better chance you have of being offered a spot.
- Starred questions are mandatory. Be sure to answer all mandatory questions to be able to move forward.

Returning Campers

- If you are only looking for the same two-week session that your camper attended in 2024, please do not apply at 8am. You are guaranteed that spot if you apply before midnight on the 1st.

Returning Campers trying to switch sessions, get a month, or have a new sister

- You should apply as soon as it opens for the best chance.
- A month option is sessions 1&2 or 3&4. A month stay is only available to current 6th graders and up.

Past Waitlisted Campers

- Be sure to apply at 8am on November 1st. We will consider past waitlisted campers before accepting new campers.

New Campers

- Be sure to enter your contact information prior to the application opening to save time. This can be done by requesting information using the link on our website.

Choose the option to create an account, choose summer 2025, complete the household form and hit submit. This can be done at any time prior to November 1.
